- 1. Volunteer for on-going programs like Propagation Society and Habitat Restoration (Saturday mornings).** Bring your friends, children and grandchildren. Learn about nature while you help restore the land.
- 2. Join the Friends of Madrona Marsh.** Your fees help support the wide range of programs and services sponsored by the Friends.
- 3. Pick up trash at the Preserve and Nature Center.** While enjoying the Preserve, help keep it tidy by picking up trash and depositing it in a trash barrel.
- 4. Volunteer your time and talent.** Madrona Marsh needs volunteers with all sorts of talents. Volunteers help run the information desk and gift shop, lead tours as docents, care for animals, raise plants and help in many ways behind the scenes.
